- 3 jalepenos, sliced in half lengthwise and cleaned
- 5 slices of bacon
- 4 ounces of cream cheese softened

Open up the chicken thigh (like a hamburger bun). Sprinkle Carolina seasoning on the inside of the chicken thigh. Smear about 1 tablespoon of cream cheese into each pepper half (use up the cheese between all of the peppers). Place the pepper inside of the chicken thigh. Wrap each chicken thigh completely with one piece of bacon and secure with toothpicks. Cook on a grill (preferably a Holland) until chicken and bacon are done. Enjoy!
